WILLAMETTE PASS RELEASE: The Ski Area release is required if one is not already on file for this season. Please download the release from http://warpracing.org/Forms/Willamete_Pass_Indemnity_Release.pdf

ALL PARTICIPANTS ARE REQUIRED TO WEAR HELMETS

RACE HQ: Race HQ will be in the Race Place – ground floor of the lodge with entrance along the west end of the lodge (left side looking uphill) Open 8am daily.

LIFT PASS: \$30.00 lift tickets for Masters and Juniors will be available each day. PNSA Elite Passes will be honored. Ages 10 and under lift tickets are \$18 daily.

RACER BIBS: Bibs will be issued each morning at Registration. Bibs must be turned in at the scoreboard upon completion of the race each day. Racers will be charged \$50.00 for missing bibs. PNSA Masters Racers may use their bibs. Please note bib number on registration.

AWARDS: Awards will be presented each day to the first 3 places in each age group according to Masters rules. Unclaimed awards for Saturday can be picked up the next morning at Race Headquarters. Awards will not be mailed.

TENTATIVE SCHEDULE: (check website on Friday 2/17 for an updated schedule). ROC reserves the right to alter the schedule due to changes in weather or ski resort circumstances. Changes will be posted at Race Headquarters and on the results board.
